PRIVATE TOURS IN PRAGUE

Introduction to Prague | 3 Hours



This tour will give you an overview of the most significant sights in Prague in just 3 hours. If you have more time I highly recommend you chose my popular and even more informative "The Best of Prague Tour". Sights to see: Old Town, Jewish Quarter (without interiors), Charles Bridge, Prague Castle. Available all year round.

The Best of Prague Tour | 6 Hours | recommended by



The all-in-one whole day tour winding along the most significant sights in Prague including a romantic boat ride under the Charles Bridge with refreshments. Break for lunch at a local traditional restaurant (lunch not included). Sights to see: Wenceslas Sq., Old Town, Astronomical Clock, Jewish Quarter (with interiors upon request), Charles Bridge, Lesser Town, Prague Castle Complex – St. Vitus Cathedral. Available all year round.



Prague Old & New Town (Right riverbank) | 4 Hours



Do you want to spend more time discovering hidden gems in Prague? Split "The Best of Prague Tour" over two days and see the left/right riverbank each day. Sights to see on the right riverbank: Old Town Square, Astronomical Clock, King's Way, Charles Bridge, Jewish Quarter (with interiors upon request + 300 czk/person), Municipal House, Wenceslas Sq. Available all year round.

Prague Castle & Lesser Town (Left riverbank) | 4 Hours



Do you want to spend more time discovering hidden gems in Prague? Split "The Best of Prague Tour" over two days and see the left / right riverbank each day. Sights to see on the left riverbank: Prague Castle Complex – St. Vitus Cathedral, Lesser Town – St. Nicholas Church, Church of Our Lady the Victorious (Infant Jesus of Prague), Charles Bridge. Available all year round.

Jewish Quarter – Josefov | 3 Hours



Explore one of the biggest Jewish sights in the world and find out why Nazis didn't destroy any of the synagogues. Sights to see (interiors): Jewish Museum – Pinkas Synagogue, Jewish Cemetery, Klausen Synagogue, Maisel Synagogue, Spanish Synagogue. Available every day except Saturdays and Jewish holidays.

Prague by Night Tour | 3 Hours



Do you want to surprise your partner with a romantic evening in Prague? Many people say Prague is even more beautiful at night when you can admire all the illuminated monumets. Your guide will also show you the best restaurants. Sights to see: Wenceslas Sq., Old Town – Old Town Sq., Astronomical Clock, King's Way, Charles Bridge, Prague Castle. Available all year around.

Private Luxury River Cruise with Champagne | 1 Hours



Are you on your honeymoon? Escape from the crowds on the Charles Bridge and enjoy a luxury boat ride along the illuminated Old Town while sipping champagne. Sights to see: Charles Bridge, Lesser Town – St. Nicholas Church, Old Town, Prague Castle Complex – St. Vitus Cathedral. Available April – November.

PRIVATE TOURS OUTSIDE OF PRAGUE

1 Hour Drive (One Way)

Karlštejn Castle & Crystal Glassworks | 7 Hours



A great tip for a day trip outside of Prague; this tour combines a visit to the most important Czech medieval castle and a unique Crystal glassworks. It is also possible to visit the Karlštejn castle only. Cheaper alternative: one hour ride by train (without glassworks). Availability: Castle: 1st – 4th January, 28th February – 15th November (except Mondays), 21st, 22nd, 28th, 29th November, 5-6th, 12-13th, 19-20th, 26th – 31st December, Glassworks: closed on weekends.

Kutná Hora & Ossuary | 7 Hours



Kutná Hora was once the second most important city in Bohemia after Prague. This medieval silver-mining town with the St. Barbara Cathedral and the so-called bone church (filled with human bones assembled in bizarre sculptures!) is certainly worth a visit. Sights to see: St. Barbara Cathedral, Italian Court, Ossuary (Bone Church). Available all year around.

City of Pilsen & Pilsner Urquell Brewery | 7 Hours



Since its foundation in 1295, the City of Pilsen has naturally become a cultural and economic centre of West Bohemia. Come along this tour and discover the tallest cathedral in the country and taste the original and world famous Pilsner. Sights to see: Pilsner Urquell Brewery, St. Bartholomew Cathedral. Available all year round.

Terezín Concentration Camp (Theresienstadt) | 5 – 6 Hours



About 140,000 people passed through Terezín's gates; more than half ended up at the death camps of Auschwitz and Treblinka. Come along this tour and learn how Nazis tricked the Red Cross investigation committee. Sights to see: Terezín Minor and Major Fortress, Museum of the Ghetto. Available all year around.

PRIVATE TOURS OUTSIDE OF PRAGUE

2 Hour Drive (One Way)

Spa Town Karlovy Vary (Carlsbad) & Moser Glassworks | 10 Hours



Karlovy Vary (Carlsbad), a world famous spa town founded in the 14th century, hosted the great names of science, politics and art including Beethoven, Franz Josef I., Paganini, Chopin, Mozart, Freud and many others. Sights to see: Carlsbad Colonnades with hot mineral springs, Moser Glassworks, thermal pool (upon request). Available all year around.

Český Krumlov | 10 Hours



Český Krumlov is a unique town of historical heritage: 300 protected medieval buildings in the historical centre designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the second largest castle complex in the Czech Republic (after the Prague Castle), and the oldest Baroque theatre in the world. You can combine this tour with a visit to České Budějovice (Budweis) and/or the Hluboká Castle. Sights to see: Krumlov Castle, Old Town, Latran. Available 21st March – 31st October.
